we pray to the Lord.

### **Sunday, February 18, Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time**

1 Sm 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23/1 Cor 15:45-49/Lk 6:27-38

That we may all become better at following the Christ-like example of selfless love demonstrated by parents caring for a child with special needs,  
we pray to the Lord.

### **Wednesday, February 21, Ash Wednesday**

Jl 2:12-18/ 2 Cor 5:20—6:2/ Mt 6:1-6, 16-18

we pray to the Lord.

### **Sunday, February 25, First Sunday of Lent**
