### **Sunday, March 11, Third Sunday of Lent**

Ex 3:1-8a, 13-15/1 Cor 10:1-6, 10-12/Lk 13:1-9 (30), or, for Cycle A,

Ex 17:3-7/Rom 5:1-2, 5-8/Jn 4:5-42 or 4:5-15, 19b-26, 39a, 40-42

In gratitude for the “long-distance caregivers” who – though they may live in another part of the country -- are taking care of loved ones who are members of our faith community,  
we pray to the Lord.

### **Sunday, March 18, Fourth Sunday of Lent**

Jos 5:9a, 10-12/2 Cor 5:17-21/Lk 15:1-3, 11-32 or, for Cycle A, 1 Sm 16:1b, 6-7, 10-13a/  
Eph 5:8-14/Jn 9:1-41 or 9:1, 6-9, 13-17, 34-38

For members of our parish who have dementia and for their loved ones who take care of them,  
we pray to the Lord.

### **Sunday, March 25, Fifth Sunday of Lent**

Is 43:16-21/Phil 3:8-14/Jn 8:1-11 or, for Cycle A, Ez 37:12-14/Rom 8:8-11/  
Jn 11:1-45 or 11:3-7, 17, 20-27, 33b-45

That as Lent draws to an end, we are generous offering assistance and respite care to family caregivers who otherwise would be unable to attend Holy Week or Easter services,  
we pray to the Lord.
